

Being a 1.000 acre tract of land out of the Lot 3, Newsome Estates, Phase II, an addition to the City of Reno, Parker County, Texas, according to the plat thereof recorded in Cabinet A, Slide 730, Plat Records, Parker County, Texas and being more particularly described by metes and bounds

BEGINNING at an Iron rod found for comer in the North line of Tiffany Street (a 60-foot wide public right-of-way), said comer being the Southeast comer of said Lot 3, and being the Southwest comer of Lot 2 of said Newsom Estates, Phase II;

THENCE North 89 deg 56 min 36 sec West, with the South line of said Lot 3 and with the North line of said Tiffany Street, a distance of 189.85 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod set for corner;

THENCE North 01 deg 10 min 42 sec West, parallel with the East line of said Lot 3, a distance of 230.04 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod set for corner, said corner being in the North line of said Lot 3, and being in the South line of Newsome Estates, an addition to the City of Reno, Parker County, Texas according to the plat thereof recorded in Volume 363-A, Page 14, of the Plat Records of Parker County, Texas;

THENCE South 01 deg 10 min 42 sec East, with the common line of said Lot 3 and Lot 2, a distance of 228.97 feet, to the POINT OF BEGINNING, and containing 1.000 acre of land, more


