Newsom Survey a distance of 410.13 feet to an old iron rod and being in the west line of Silver Creek Road; THENCE S. 10° 30' E., along the west line of said Silver Creek Road and along a irregular fence a distance of 450.56 feet to an old iron rod; THENCE N. 10° 30' W., along an irregular fence a distance of 441.7 feet to an old iron rod; THENCE S. 10° 30' E., along a irregular fence a distance of 299.25 feet to an old iron rod; THENCE S. 10° 30' W., along an irregular fence a distance of 105.56 feet to an old iron rod; THENCE S. 10° 30' E., along a irregular fence a distance of 476.13 feet to an old iron rod; THENCE S. 10° 30' W., along the west line of said Silver Creek Road; THENCE S. 10° 30' E., along the east line of said Silver Creek Road and along an irregular fence a distance of 465.13 feet to an old iron rod; THENCE N. 10° 30' W., along the north line of said Silver Creek Road and along a irregular fence a distance of 410.56 feet to an old iron rod; THENCE S. 10° 30' E., along the west line of said Silver Creek Road a distance of 512.0 feet to an iron rod at the Northeast corner of a 15.1 acre tract; THENCE N. 10° 30' W., a distance of 112.97 feet to an iron rod; THENCE N. 10° 30' E., along an irregular fence a distance of 132.07 feet to an old iron rod; THENCE N. 10° 30' W., along an irregular fence a distance of 174.37 feet to an old iron rod; THENCE N. 10° 30' E., along an irregular fence a distance of 170.57 feet to an iron rod at the Northeast corner of the tract; Cora A. 
