TO: Taxing Entities Participating in Wise CAD Appraisal Budget:

The attached pages represent the Proposed 2019 Budget for Appraisal Services provided by the Wise County Tax Appraisal District. The Board of Directors will consider this budget at the Wise County Appraisal District Board of Directors Meeting to be held at 5:00 P.M. August 21, 2018. Meeting will be held in the Board Meeting Room of the Wise County Appraisal District located at 400 East Business 380 Decatur, Texas.

The changes to the budget from 2018 are as follows:

- 1. PAYROLL Wise County is experiencing explosive growth! New home construction is booming and looks to continue. In addition the sale of existing homes is at an all time high too! With explosive growth has come an increase in the properties to be measured, appraised, and protested. 2018 Protests were over 12,500, up from 4,600 in 2017. We are proposing to add another position to help manage the appraisal and protests. Also proposing cost of living salary adjustments for existing staff. Insurance rates have held stable with slightly less coverage offered. Retirement rate increased slightly to 9.50%.
- 2. CAR TRAVEL Additional funding for new position.
- 3. CONTRACTS & RENTALS We entered a new 2 year contract for Mineral / Industrial Appraisals with Capital Appraisal Group at \$233,200 per year. Aerial imagery cost is higher as new images will be flown in 2019. Broke out the cost of Multiple Listing Service for residential and CoStar Comps for commercial analysis in to separate line item.

- 4. **SPECIAL SERVICES** Litigation continues to be steady with some commercial properties filing annually. Legislature and courts have not looked favorable on valuation litigation.
- 5. **DATA PROCESSING** Adding outside data monitoring / security due to heightened cyber security issues.
- **6. EQUIPMENT / BUILDING MAINTENANCE -** Increasing amount for building maintenance as structure has aged.
- 7. **GENERAL OFFICE** Postage costs have increased with certified mail requirements on taxpayer notifications. ARB mailings have driven these costs up considerably also.
- **8. CAPITAL OUTLAY** Starting program to replace aging personal computers, most are over 5 years of age. Will replace on a rotation basis.
- 9. OTHER SERVICES ARB cases continue to increase with re-scheduling by taxpayers and agents adding to the work load. With explosive growth has come an increase in the properties protested. 2018 Protests were over 12,500, up from 4,600 in 2017. Increased cost of educating staff as staff grows. Building security increased for all ARB meetings.

In summary the 2019 Wise County Appraisal Budget for Appraisal Services is up from 2018 with the explosive growth happening now. Final allocation amounts will be determined once final budget is approved. Appraisal Budget allocations are up from 2018 reflecting budget changes.
