2025 PROPERTY TAX STATEMENTS

Most Parker County property tax statements will be mailed soon. However, approximately 4,800 statements will be delayed this year. These delays apply to properties in districts where adopted tax rates must be approved by voters.

This delay will not affect payment options, deadlines, penalties, or interest. Taxpayers can view and pay their property taxes online once they are posted. Official paper statements for these accounts will not be mailed until after the election. Property taxes are due upon receipt and will not be considered delinquent if paid by January 31, 2026.

The October statements reflect recent changes passed by the Texas Legislature, even though voters have not yet cast their ballots. These include a \$140,000 homestead exemption and a \$200,000 exemption for homeowners over 65 or disabled on school district portion of the tax bill, if they qualify. If these propositions do not pass, supplemental tax bills will be issued for the difference.

Taxes must be paid in U.S. currency by cash, check, money order, or credit/debit card. Payment options include:

For convenience, a drive-thru and after-hours drop box are available at the front-door vestibule and drive-thru of the building.

If your property has a mortgage with an escrow account, the requesting mortgage company will be mailed a duplicate statement with the amount due. Taxpayers may also obtain tax statements and receipts online at www.parkercad.org.
