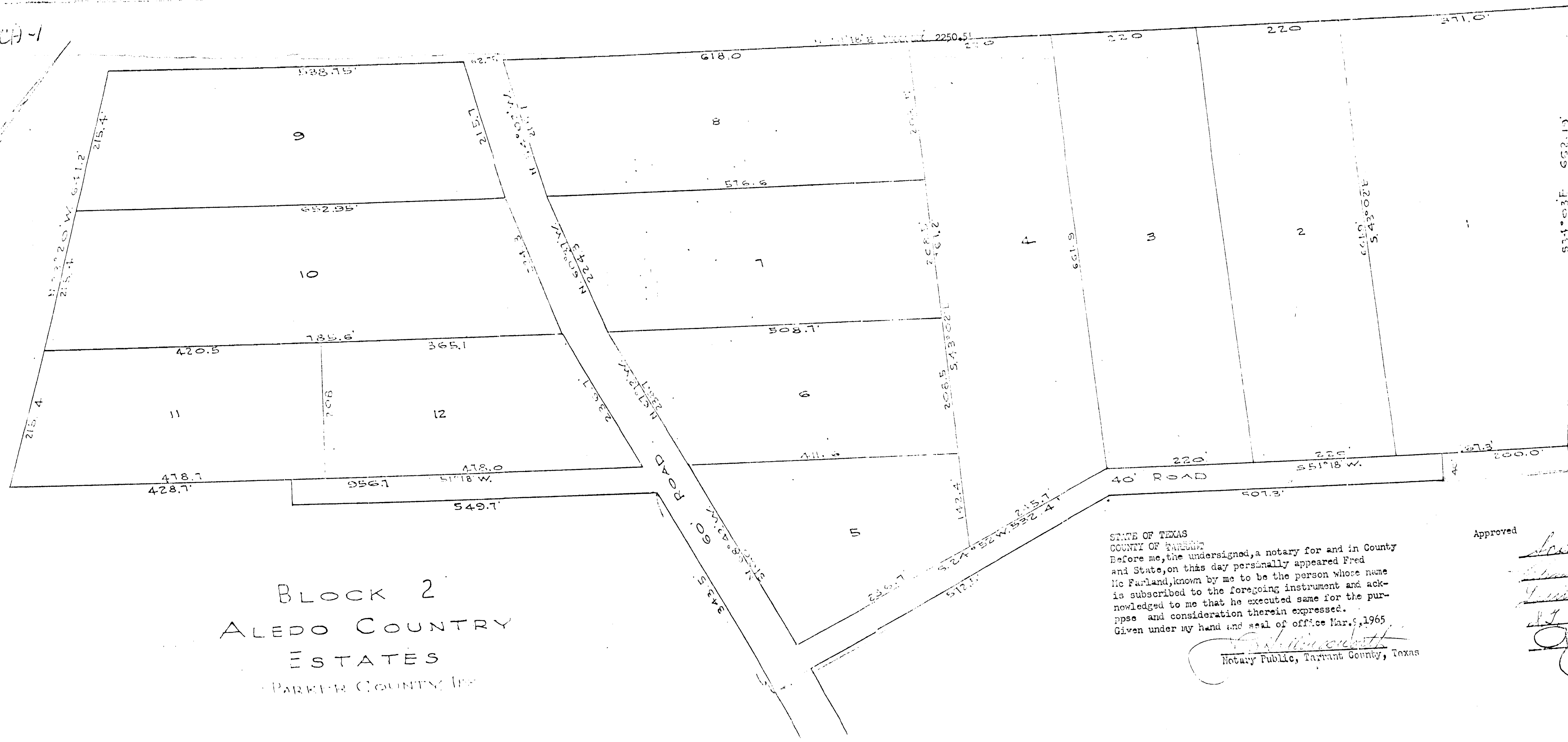

Field Note Description of a tract of land containing 37.42 Acres of land and being a part of I & G N R R SURVEY NO.5, Abstract No.1825 in Parker County, Texas and being described by metes and bounds as follows. BEGINNING at an iron pin set for corner in the South corner of Lot 13, Block I, Aledo Country Estates, said iron pin being North 676.55' and West 1756.2' from the NE corner of the H. Nichols Survey. THENCE N 51 deg 18' E along the South line of Block No. I and the North line of Block No. II to an iron pin for corner in the NE corner of Lot No. I, Block No. II., a distance of 2250.5' THENCE S 34 deg 02' E along the East line of Lot 1 662.19' to an iron pin for corner. THENCE S 51 deg 18' W 200' to iron pin. THENCE S 38 deg 42' E 40.0' THENCE S 51 deg 18' W 507.3' THENCE S 24 deg 52' W 572.5' to iron pin SW line of a 60' gravel road. THENCE N 68 deg 42' W along line of road 343.5' to a point in SBL of a 40' road THENCE S 51 deg 18' W along SBL road 549.7' THENCE N 38 deg 42' W 40' THENCE N 51 deg 18' W along SBL of of Lot 11 to an iron pin set for corner. THENCE N 23 deg 20' W along the West line of Lots 11, 10 and 9 a distance of 647.2' to the place of beginning.
