Thence N 89° 17' W 897.5 ft. to an iron pin set in ground for corner on the West boundary line of a county road.

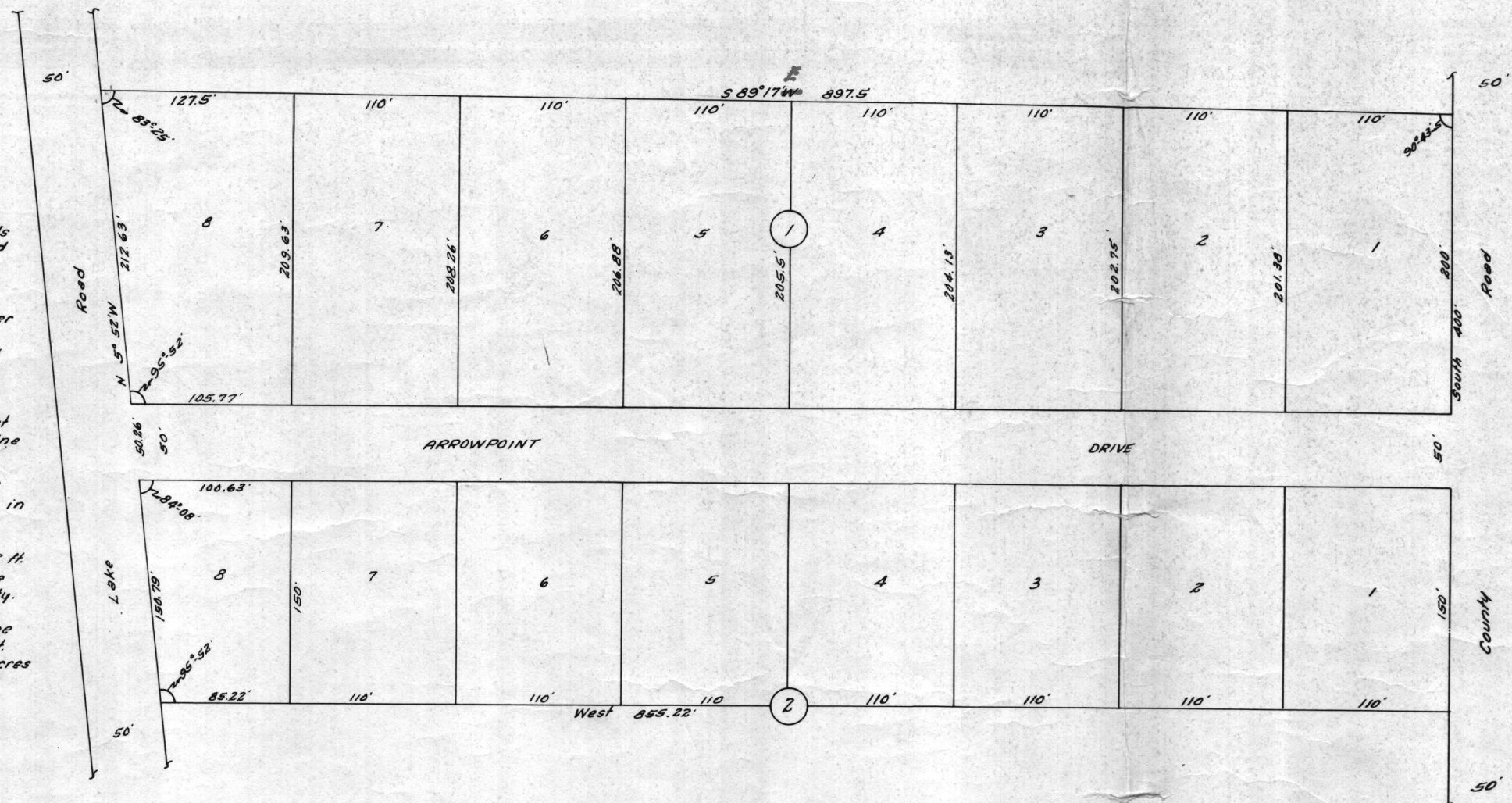
Thence South with said west boundary line of said county road 400.0 ft. to an iron pin set in ground for corner.
