

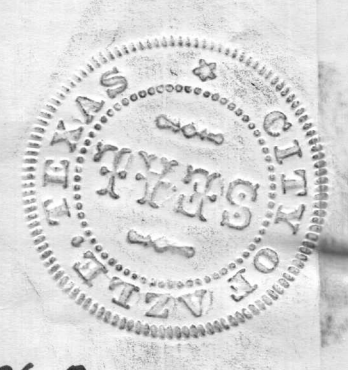
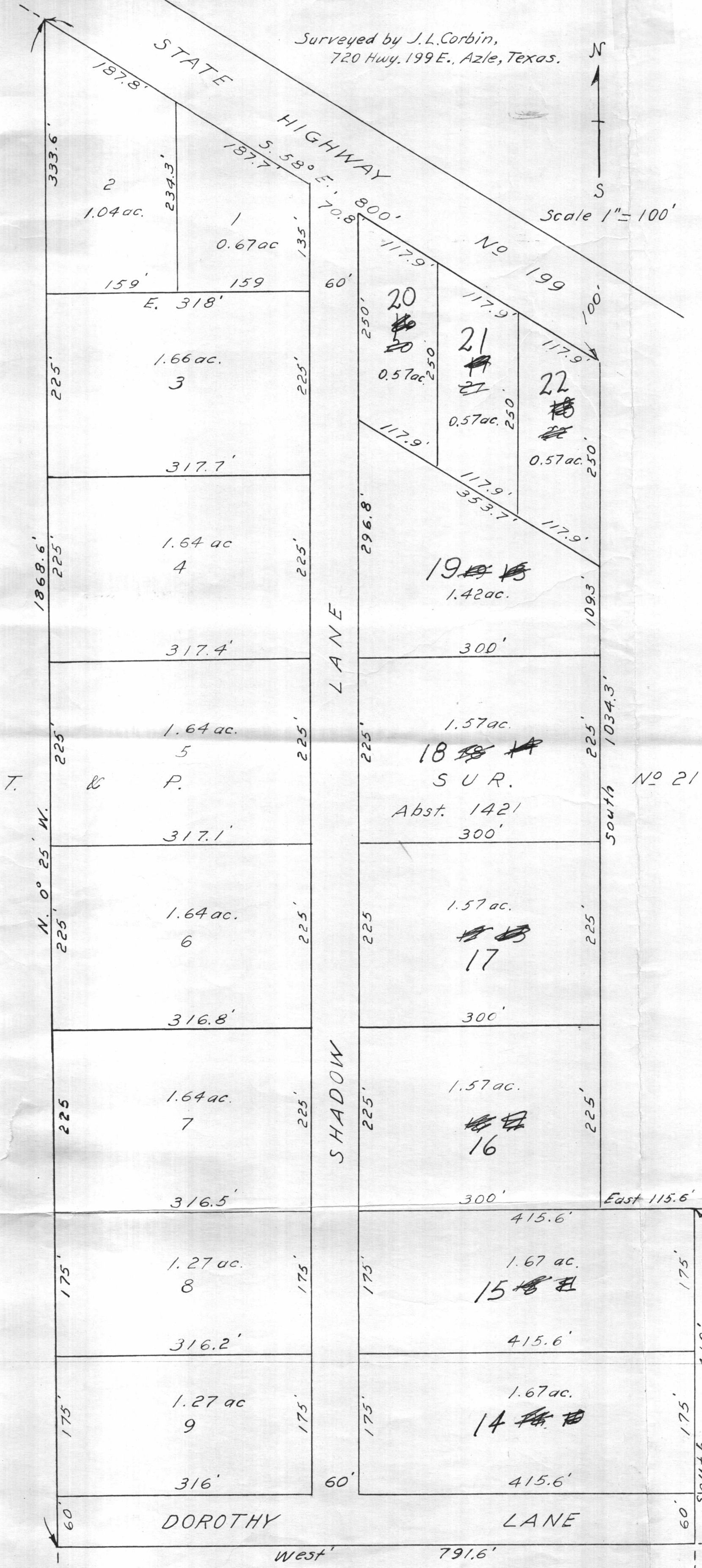

Commencing at the N.W. corner of the J. Rash Survey, Abst. 1114, Parker County, Texas
 Thence South 410 ft. along the West line of said J. Rash Survey to an iron pin;
 Thence West 791.6 ft. to an iron pin in a division line fence;
 Thence N. 0° 25' W., 1868.6 ft. along said division line fence to an iron pin in the South right-of-way line of State Highway No. 199;
 Thence S. 58° E., 800 ft. along said right-of-way line to an iron pin in a division line fence;
 Thence South 1034.3 ft. along said fence to an iron pin;
 Thence East 115.6' along a division line fence to an iron pin, containing 26.47 acres of land, more or less.
