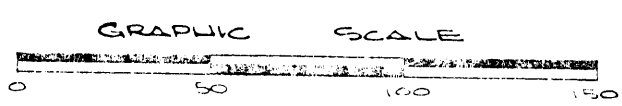

 follows:

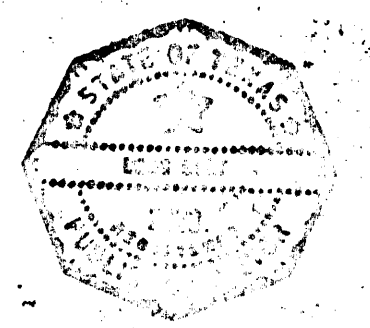
- Beginning at an iron pin being 828.0 feet South and 200.0 feet West of
