


VICINITY MAP

improvements may be placed in landscape easements, if approved by the City Council of the City of Weatherford. The City of Weatherford and public utility entities shall at all times have the full right of ingress and egress to or from their respective easements for the purpose of constructing, reconstructing inspecting, patrolling, maintaining, reading meters and adding to or removing all or parts of their respective systems without the necessity at any time procuring permission from anyone
