Chief Appraiser – Kim Haralson gave the following report:

The Financial Audit has been delayed due to COVID in the audit firms office.

Kayla Epperson – Field Appraisal Clerk – quit on Monday – March 8, 2021.

CDM has withdrawn their protest on compressors.

The 2020 Ratio Study results are 99% on Residential and 100% on Land/Minerals.

Information from a meeting with Pritchard & Abbott, indicates oil prices for 2021 are predicted at \$44 - \$45 per barrel, with production down from previous years. Gas prices are holding.

The 2021 Notices of Value are scheduled to go out the 1st of April.

Current Tax Collections are at 93.4%.
