FY 2026 ADOPTED BUDGET

REQUIRED TAXPAYER IMPACT STATEMENT WHEN DISCUSSING OR ADOPTING A BUDGET:

Texas Government Code §551.043 as amended by HB 1522 and effective September 1, 2025, requires a taxpayer impact statement showing, for the median-valued homestead property in each governmental body, a comparison of the property tax bill for the current fiscal year to an estimate of the property tax bill for the upcoming fiscal year if the proposed budget is adopted.

The Tom Green County Appraisal District does not adopt a tax rate and does not directly levy property taxes. The District's adopted 2026 budget is funded through allocations from participating taxing units pursuant to Texas Tax Code §6.06.
