Filing a Complaint with the Appraisal District

Instructions for Filing a Complaint

Only written complaints will be accepted.

When you file a complaint, please include the following information:

- Your name, address and telephone number
- Your email address, if you would like to be contacted via email
- The name of the person or persons about whom you are complaining
- The date, if applicable, of the incident about which you are complaining
- The exact nature of the complaint

The complaints directed to the Taxpayer Liaison Officer will be addressed at the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Directors meeting.

You will receive notification from the taxpayer liaison officer regarding the complaint, either by email, phone call, or written response. You will also be notified of the board meeting date and time.
