The 2020 Ratio Study results are 99% on Residential and 100% on Land/Minerals.

Information from a meeting with Pritchard & Abbott, indicates oil prices for 2021 are predicted at \$44 - \$45 per barrel, with production down from previous years. Gas prices are holding.

The 2021 Notices of Value are scheduled to go out the 1<sup>st</sup> of April.

Current Tax Collections are at 93.4%.
